


NURSING ASSISTANT-CERTIFIED HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM at RUSD DUE DATES & PROGRAM INFORMATION

We are offering a Nurse Assistant-Certified program this fall at Colton Adult School after school and on seven Saturdays. Any Redlands Unified School District Junior or Senior may attend.

- Classes will meet on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 4:00pm-8:00pm and 9 scheduled Saturdays from 7:30am-4:00pm.
- Theory classes are offered in person at Redlands High School and clinicals will take place at a local long-term healthcare facility.
- Some Saturday theory classes will take place at the ROP's main campus at 1214 Indiana Court, Redlands CA 92374.

The NA-C program is a competitive program, meaning students must apply and will be selected into the program. The scoring rubric is attached.

Steps to Enrollment & Due Dates for the Nurse Assistant- Certified RUSD Nurse Assistant-Certified class:



After School Classes, Nurse Assistant (see Registration Application & Due Dates)

08/28/2024	Deadline to submit Application (Must be complete to be considered for acceptance into the program). Submit before 5:00pm.
08/28-30/2024	Application will be scored and ranked.
08/30/2024	All students selected to the program or placed on the waitlist will be contacted by email. Watch for emails. Once contacted registration instructions will be given.
08/30-09/12/2024	Students complete the on-line registration process by completing the forms emailed by the Student Services-Registration office. The emails sent will say they are from the "Orbund Admin" which is part of our Student Information System.
09/4 at 5:00pm or 09/5 at 6:00pm	Mandatory Student/Parent or Guardian Orientation Meeting. Each student must attend an Orientation meeting with their parent or guardian. Meetings will be held via zoom.
10/03/2024	Physicals, TB results, seasonal flu shot, and verification of COVID vaccinations and boosters if they apply must be submitted to teacher by 03/01/24. A declination can be signed if the student has a religious or medical reason for non-COVID vaccination.

Things to Remember:

- Students must have a current, legal ID and original social security card.
- Students are required to maintain 70% class performance and 93% class attendance.
- The CA Department of Public Health monitors this program and requires students to finish all required theory modules prior to the start of clinical. To sit for the state exam, all students must complete a minimum of 100 clinical hours and have a passing grade of a C- or better in the program.
- Students must have regular attendance in class.
- Students must purchase their own uniforms. Uniforms can be purchased for \$40 a set from CRY-ROP.
