Program Description:

Nurse Assistant–Certified-This program is designed to prepare students for employment as a Certified Nurse Assistant in a variety of settings. Students will learn patient care, observation and communication skills with an emphasis on caring for the geriatric resident in a long-term care facility. The program prepares students to be successful in the work place by teaching instruction (theory) and 100 required clinical hours.

Program Prerequisites:

Basic reading & math assessment required. Call for testing appointment. Testing is free.

Students are required to attend all class/clinical sessions as scheduled.

Students are required to have proof of a current physical, TB screening, proof of annual flu and COVID immunizations.

- **Maintain a minimum of 70% grade average and 93% attendance**
- **Must be able to perform job functions (physical and sensory demands)**
- **Must be able to clear a criminal background check (Live Scan). CDPH makes the final approval of Certification. For questions, please refer to www.cdph.ca.gov**
- **Clinical site training (at least 100 hours) is a requirement of this program**
- **Upon completion of the program, students should possess a willingness to secure employment**
- **CIEL or CIEW tops & black pants. Two sets of uniforms provided.**
