**Program Description:**

This program is designed to prepare students for employment as a Certified Nurse Assistant in a variety of settings. Students will learn patient care, observation, and communication skills with an emphasis on caring for the geriatric resident in a long-term care facility. The program prepares students to be successful in the workplace by teaching employability skills and modeling workplace expectations. The program includes both in-person classroom instruction (i.e., theory) and 100 clinical hours. Students will take the state certification exam at the end of the program. **Students must attend all classes as scheduled in order to meet State of California requirements.**

**Prerequisite:**

- Students must have a current legal ID & original a Social Security Card (**Original cards are required**).
- Students who are seniors are invited to apply to attend the program.
- This is a competitive process. Students must complete the application and the highest scoring students will be selected.
- Students will need a physical, TB screening, seasonal flu shot and COVID-19 vaccination(s).
- Students must provide a pair of white or black shoes that won't penetrate liquid.
- Students will need to purchase class uniforms (uniforms available for \$40 per set).

**Items Provided:** Workbook, Live Scan fingerprinting, State Testing Fee & BLS American Heart Assoc. CPR/AED Training/Card/Book. **Do not get the health screenings or purchase uniforms until you are accepted.**
