

CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM AT RUSD DUE DATES & PROGRAM INFORMATION

We are offering a Nurse Assistant-Certified program this spring at Redlands High School after school and on five Saturdays. Any Redlands Unified School District senior may apply.

- Classes will meet on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 4:00pm-8:00pm and five scheduled Saturdays from 7:30am-4:00pm.
- Theory classes are offered in person at Redlands High School and clinicals will take place at a local long-term healthcare facility.
- Some Saturday theory classes will take place at the ROP's main campus at 1214 Indiana Court, Redlands CA 92374.

The NA-C program is a competitive program, meaning students must apply and will be selected into the program. The scoring rubric is attached.

Steps to Enrollment & Due Dates for the Certified Nurse Assistant RUSD class:

12/5/2024	Enrollment opens & information posted on our website at <u>www.cryrop.org</u> and select "High School Opportunity"
01/05/2025	Deadline to submit Application. Application must be complete to be considered for acceptance into the program. Submit before 11:59pm.
01/06/2025-01/09/2025	Applications scored and ranked.
01/10/2025	All students selected to the program or placed on the waitlist will be contacted by e-mail. Once contacted registration instructions will be given.
1/10/2025 - 01/17/2025	Students complete the online registration process by completing the forms e-mailed by the Student Services office. The e-mails sent will say they are from the "Orbund Admin" which is part of our Student Information System.
01/16/2025	Mandatory Student and Parent/Guardian Orientation Meeting. Each student must attend an Orientation meeting with their parent/guardian. Meetings will be held via Teams.
02/05/2025	Physicals, TB results, seasonal flu shot, and verification of COVID vaccinations and boosters if they apply must be submitted to teacher by 02/05/2025. A declination can be signed if the student has a religious or medical reason for non-COVID vaccination.

Things to Remember:

- Students must have a current, legal ID and original social security card.
- Students are required to maintain 70% class performance and 93% class attendance.
- The California Department of Public Health monitors this program and requires students to finish all required theory modules prior to the start of clinical. To sit for the state exam, all students must complete a minimum of 100 clinical hours and have a passing grade of a C- or better in the program.
- Students must have regular attendance in class.
- Students must purchase their own uniforms. Uniforms can be purchased for \$40 a set from CRY-ROP.
